- A programme of activities at the marae to involve the iwi and bring them back to the marae so it once again becomes the centre of Hineuru life.

I have a copy of the development plan that I recommend we receive at our AGM today. Our path moving forward has been designed by Hineuru for Hineuru. "Mai Hineuru, mo Hineuru".

I would like to acknowledge my fellow trustees for their time and commitment as well as their contribution to the development of Hineuru. Thank you for the hard work that you put in and the work that has been completed outside the eyes of our people.

Finally I wish to thank our **Hineuru people**. We are the beginning of a new chapter for our people. It is exciting it is a new territory and it will challenge all of us.
